A gift for a fraudster?



Protect yourself and others: ask...

- Have you received a call from someone claiming you have an outstanding debt?
- Did the caller request a payment by iTunes or STEAM vouchers to clear the debt?

iTunes and STEAM vouchers cannot be used as a payment of debt, they are gift cards.

There is a national trend of fraudsters claiming to be the tax office, HMRC or the immigration office.

The fraudster claims there is an outstanding debt that needs to be settled with “payment” cards.

This is fraud. Contact the police on 101 or report to Action Fraud on 0300 123 2040.
