- Have an NVQ Level 3 qualification (or equivalent) or experience as a Special Constable or PCSO
- No criminal convictions (minor offences will be considered on an individual basis)
- Meet our attendance standard
- Be able to pass the job related fitness test
- Have no visible tattoos
